

RED CROSS RECOMMENDATIONS & KEY MESSAGES

RED CROSS RECOMMENDATIONS & KEY MESSAGES ON THE ROADMAP "A COMPREHENSIVE APPROACH TO MENTAL HEALTH"

The Red Cross EU Office (RCEU), representing the 27 National Red Cross Societies in the EU, the Norwegian Red Cross, the leathanck Red Cross and the International Federation of Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies (IFRC), supports the EU in advocating for a comprehensive and cross-sectoral approach to mental health and psychosocial support (MHPSS).

In their unique role supporting health and social protection system as auxiliaries to public authorities and as member of the world's largest volunteers-based network, National Ro-Cross and Red Crescent Societies, carry out an important and diverse work in providing quality MHPSS worldwide, in close proximity to the affected people and their communities from basic psychosocial support through to specialized mental health care, while responding to the extensive unmet MHPSS needs, in all contexts and at all times.

RCEU and its members strongly affirm that mental health cannot wait and that there is no health without mental health. We welcome the European Commission's ambition of developing one single initiative on mental health aiming at guiding EU Member States in all strands of EU actions. This promising approach can only deliver with 1) a clear timeline, adequate budget, objectives, as well as indicators to monitor progress; 2) all stakeholders on board, including affected individuals themselves, allowing a comprehensive collection of observations and ensuring a successful cross-sectoral uptake of stakeholders. Driven by policy, the EU approach should be complemented with a bottom-up approach boosting community interventions. Dehaviour change and addressing stimus.

We hope that this initiative will ensure synergies with existing policies – in particular, the EU Care Strategy, the EU Youth Strategy, the Healthier together initiative, the new EU Global Health Strategy – and contribute to shaping the EU and Member States' position on MHPSS in the global policy sphere, including when advocating towards the implementation of the Universal Health Coverage.


